Tournament Rules:

1. Players will start with 10,000 in tournament chips.
2. On-Site Registration available until the start of Level 7 of each starting day of this event.
3. Players may Re-Enter until the start of Level 7.
4. Players may not bag and play a subsequent flight. If a player bags and plays a subsequent flight they will have all chips removed from play. Players may forfeit their stack to Re-Enter or participate in subsequent starting day.
5. Alternates and late sign-ups will enter the tournament with a full chip stack and no obligation from it.
6. This is a two-day tournament with six starting flights. Levels will last 30 minutes each.
7. Day 1 will end at the conclusion of Level 14 or 12% of the field, whichever comes first. Tournament Director's discretion may also be used. Day 2 will play until conclusion or 3AM. If one table remains at 3AM, players will have the option to play to a conclusion if all remaining players agree. If not completed, play will resume at 2PM the following day.
8. Redraw at the end of Day 1 and at 27 and 10 players or at Tournament Director discretion.
9. Tournament Director decisions are final and without recourse.
10. Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on the website or printed material pertaining to this event, and players will have no claim in these matters.
11. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It's each and every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
12. Seating may be limited for this event.
13. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
14. Tournament tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable.
15. \$120 will go into the prize pool. \$20 is the registration fee. \$10 will go towards the staff token pool.
