- 3. Players will start with 12,000 in tournament units. Levels will last 20 minutes.
- 4. On-Site Registration will be available until 11:59PM on Tuesday, August 9th, 2016.
- 5. Bracket unveiling with occur on Wednesday, August 10th, 2016.
- 6. With a field of 64 players final 8 players will be in the money. Tournament will use Pay Chart HEADSUP.
- 7. Day 1 will end after 3 rounds of matches. Day 2 will return Friday, August 12th @ 2PM.
- 8. Tournament Director's decisions are final and without recourse.
- 9. Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on the website or printed material pertaining to this event, and players will have no claim in these matters.
- 10. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It's each and every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
- 11. Tournament tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable.
