1. Players will start with 15,000 in tournament units. This is a two-day tournament with one starting day.
2. On-Site Registration available until the start of Level 5. After initial tables have been filled, any further registration must be in increments of 10 players.
3. Alternates and late sign-ups will enter the tournament with a full chip stack and no obligation from it.
4. Day 1 Levels will last 30 minutes each. Day 2 Levels will last 40 minutes each. Seating will be limited to 100 players.
5. Players must win their table in order to advance to Day 2. Day 1 will conclude once all tables have finished. Day 2 will play until conclusion. Players will bring their chips from Day 1 to the Final Table.
6. Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on the website or printed material pertaining to this event, and players will have no claim in these matters. Tournament Director's decisions are final and without recourse.
7. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It's every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, situations, or irregularities.
8. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
9. Tournament tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable.
