- 2. On-Site Registration and a single re-entry option are available until the start of Level 9.
- 3. Alternates and late sign-ups will enter the tournament with a full chip stack and no obligation from it.
- 4. Tournament will be played 6 handed with a 7 handed Final Table.
- 5. Levels will last 30 minutes each. Seating may be limited for this event.
- 6. In the event that one table remains at 3AM, players will have the option to play to a conclusion if all remaining players agree. If not completed, play will resume at 3PM the following day.
- 7. Redraw at 18 and 7 players or at Tournament Director's discretion.
- 8. Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on the website or printed material pertaining to this event, and players will have no claim in these matters. Tournament Director's decisions are final and without recourse.
- 9. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
- 10. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It's each and every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
- 11. Tournament tickets are non-transferrable and non-refundable. No refunds.
- 12. \$300 will go into the prize pool. \$40 is the registration fee. \$20 will go towards the staff toke pool.
