- 3. Alternates and late sign-ups will enter the tournament with a full chip stack and no obligation from it.
- 4. Levels will last 15 minutes each. Seating may be limited for this event.
- 5. This event will be played 8 handed.
- 6. A single ante will be paid from the big blind for the entire table. The ante is paid before the Big Blind.
- 7. Redraw at 16 and 9 players or at Tournament Director's discretion.
- 8. Tournament Director's decisions are final.
- 9. Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on the website or printed material pertaining to this event, and players will have no claim in these matters. Tournament Director's decisions are final.
- 10. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
- 11. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It's each and every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
- 12. Tournament tickets are non-transferrable and non-refundable. No refunds.
- 13. \$2,000 entry fee will be used to fund the prize pool. \$200 is a registration fee of which \$60 will go towards staffing.
