- 3. Alternates and late sign-ups will enter the tournament with a full chip stack and no obligation from it.
- 4. The event will be played 8-handed and levels will last 30 minutes each.
- 5. In the event that one table remains at 3AM, players will have the option to play to a conclusion if all remaining players agree. If not completed, play will resume at 3PM the following day.
- 6. Redraw at 16 and 9 players or at Tournament Director's discretion.
- 7. Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on the website or printed material pertaining to this event, and players will have no claim in these matters. Tournament Director's decisions are final.
- 8. Seating may be limited for this event.
- 9. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
- 10. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It's each and every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
- 11. Tournament tickets are non-transferrable and non-refundable. No refunds.
- 12. \$340 entry fee will be used to fund the prize pool. \$60 is a registration fee of which \$20 will go towards staffing.
