Tournament Rules:

1. Players will start with 25,000 in tournament chips. **Seating may be limited for this event.**
2. There is Single Re-Entry option in this event. This is a three-day tournament with one starting day.
3. On-Site Registration available until the start of Level 10.
4. Alternates and late sign-ups will enter the tournament with a full chip stack and no obligation from it.
5. Day 1 levels will last 40 minutes. Day 2 levels will last 60 minutes. Day 3 Final Table levels will be 90 minutes. Heads-up play will be 60 minutes.
6. A single ante will be paid from the big blind for the entire table. **The ante is paid before the Big Blind.**
7. Day 1 will end at the end of level 14. Day 2 will end when 9 players remain or at Tournament Director's discretion.
8. Redraw at 27, 18, and 9 players or at Tournament Director's discretion.
9. Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on the website or printed material pertaining to this event, and players will have no claim in these matters. Tournament Director's decisions are final.
10. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It's each and every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
11. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
12. Tournament tickets are non-refundable.
13. \$2,425 entry fee will be used to fund the prize pool. \$225 is a registration fee of which \$75 will go towards staffing.
