Tournament Rules:

1. Players will start with 20,000 in tournament chips.
2. On-Site registration and re-entry available until the start of Level 9. No Refunds.
3. Levels 1-12 will last 30 minutes each. Levels 13+ will last 40 minutes. This is a one-day tournament.
4. This tournament will be played 9 handed.
5. Redraw at 18 and 9 players or at tournament director's discretion.
6. Players may forfeit their stack at the end of registration to re-enter.
7. Alternates and late sign-ups will enter the tournament with a full chip stack and no obligation from it.
8. A single ante will be paid from the big blind for the entire table. *The ante is paid before the Big Blind.*
9. Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on the website or printed material pertaining to this event, and players will have no claim in these matters. Tournament Director's decisions are final.
10. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It's each and every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
11. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
12. Tournament tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable.
13. \$970 entry fee will be used to fund the prize pool. \$130 is a registration fee of which \$30 will go towards staffing.
