Tournament Rules:

- 1. Players will start with 30,000 in tournament chips.
- 2. Levels will last 40 minutes each. This is a two-day tournament.
- On-site registration and unlimited re-entries available until the start of level 10. Players may forfeit their tournament chips at the end of registration to re-enter. 15 Minute break at the end of level 3,6,12,15. 60 Min Dinner Break at end of level 9.
- 4. Entries purchased prior to the start of the tournament will be considered live and in play. Alternates and late entries purchased after the start of the tournament will have no obligation and will not be live until the player has been dealt in. Alternates and late entries may have to wait for a seating assignment. Alternates not sat during the registration period will be entitled to a refund.
- 5. This tournament is played in big blind ante format. A single ante will be owed from the big blind in the amount of the blind level each hand. The ante is paid before the big blind.
- 6. Big Blind Ante will be used in this PLO event, however the ante will not be calculated in the opening PLO preflop raise.
- Management reserves the right to alter, change or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on websites or printed materials and players will have no claim in these matters.
- Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible of the foreign chips will be disqualified with no refund. It is all tournament players' responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
- 9. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to tax withholdings.
- 10. Tournament entries are non-transferable and non-refundable. Entries won through Poker Room promotions into this tournament are non-transferable and non-refundable.
- 11. This tournament will be played 6 handed. Games will change every 6 hands. Redraw at 12 and 7 players or at tournament director's discretion.
- 12. Day 1 will end after level 15. Day 2 will play until conclusion.
- 13. \$2,450 entry fee will be used to fund the prize pool. \$250 is the registration fee of which \$75 will go towards staffing.
- 14. This tournament uses Pay Chart Six-Max.
