Tournament Rules:

1. Players will start with 25,000 in tournament chips.
2. Levels will last 20 minutes each. This is a one-day tournament.
3. On-site registration and unlimited re-entries available until the start of level 7. Players may forfeit their tournament chips at the end of registration to re-enter.
4. Entries purchased prior to the start of the tournament will be considered live and in play. Alternates and late entries purchased after the start of the tournament will have no obligation and will not be live until the player has been dealt in. Alternates and late entries may have to wait for a seating assignment. Alternates not sat during the registration period will be entitled to a refund.
5. This tournament is played in big blind ante format. A single ante will be owed from the big blind in the amount of the blind level each hand. The ante is paid before the big blind.
6. Management reserves the right to alter, change or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on websites or printed materials and players will have no claim in these matters.
7. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible of the foreign chips will be disqualified with no refund. It is all tournament players’ responsibility to bring to management’s attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
8. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to tax withholdings.
9. Tournament entries are non-transferable and non-refundable. Entries won through Poker Room promotions into this tournament are non-transferable and non-refundable.
10. All players will be given a “nit” plaque to start the tournament.
11. When a player wins a hand regardless of what round of betting it occurs on (pre-flop, flop, turn or river) and the players shows both of their cards they will turn in their “nit” plaque to the dealer.
12. If a player winning the hand does not show their cards they must keep their “nit’ plaque.
13. The last player holding their “nit” plaque must pay the “nit tax”.
 - The “nit tax” will be in the form of 3 complete rounds (small, big blind and big blind ante) of blinds at the current level placed in the pot of the next hand.
 - If the “nit tax” puts a player all-in they will still receive a hand, but are only eligible for the “dead money” (“nit tax” and “big blind ante”)
14. Once that current round of “nit” has been completed the dealer will pass out the “nit” plaques to all players at the table.
15. When a table breaks and tables are combined players that still have a “nit” plaque must take the plaque to their new table.
16. If a player from a broken table does not have a “nit” plaque they will
 - Not get a “nit” plaque until the new round starts or
 - Get a “nit” plaque if a new round has started at the new table and a hand has not been dealt to start that round.
17. Players must have been dealt into a table to be subject to the “nit” tax.
18. This tournament will be played 9 handed.
19. Redraw at 18 and 9 players or at tournament director’s discretion.
20. \$255 entry fee will be used to fund the prize pool. \$45 is the registration fee of which \$15 will go towards staffing.
21. This tournament uses Pay Chart A.
