Tournament Rules:

1. Players will start with 50,000 in tournament chips.
2. No clock will be used to determine the limit of play. The limit will increase maintaining a minimum 50 Big Blind Average as players are eliminated. This is a two-day tournament.
3. On-site registration and unlimited re-entries available until 2:15PM. Players may forfeit their tournament chips at the end of registration to re-enter.
4. A 15-minute break will be offered every 2 hours.
5. Entries purchased prior to the start of the tournament will be considered live and in play. Alternates and late entries purchased after the start of the tournament will have no obligation and will not be live until the player has been dealt in. Alternates and late entries may have to wait for a seating assignment. Alternates not sat during the registration period will be entitled to a refund.
6. This tournament is played in big blind ante format. A single ante will be owed from the big blind in the amount of the blind level each hand. The big blind is paid before the ante.
7. Management reserves the right to alter, change or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on websites or printed materials and players will have no claim in these matters.
8. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible of the foreign chips will be disqualified with no refund. It is all tournament players' responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
9. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to tax withholdings.
10. Tournament entries are non-transferable and non-refundable. Entries won through Poker Room promotions into this tournament are non-transferable and non-refundable.
11. This tournament will be played 8 handed.
12. Redraw at 24 and 9 players or at tournament director's discretion.
13. An action clock will be in play at the start of the tournament until conclusion. Action clock increments will be 20 seconds preflop and 30 second post flop with 30 second extensions. 4 time extensions at the start of play, 4 additional at the start of the final three tables, and 5 additional at the start of the final table of 9. Time extensions will accumulate and not be reset.
14. Day 1 will play down to 9 players. Day 2 will play until the conclusion.
15. \$520 entry fee will be used to fund the prize pool. \$80 is the registration fee of which \$26 will go towards staffing.
16. This tournament uses Pay Chart Eight-Handed.
