1. Players will start with 20,000 in tournament chips. Players will carry forward all chips from round to round.
2. Levels will last 20 minutes each. This is a two-day tournament.
3. This tournament will sell out at a 32 player cap.
4. A random draw for First Round Matches will take place at 12P on Monday April 20.
5. Registration will close for this event at 12PM on Monday April 20. If event is not sold out late registration will remain open until the end of level 1.
6. No Re-Entry and No Refunds.
7. Entries purchased prior to the start of the tournament will be considered live and in play.
8. Management reserves the right to alter, change or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on websites or printed materials and players will have no claim in these matters.
9. Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible of the foreign chips will be disqualified with no refund. It is all tournament players' responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
10. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to tax withholdings.
11. Tournament entries are non-transferable and non-refundable. Entries won through Poker Room promotions into this tournament are non-transferable and non-refundable.
12. This tournament will be played 2 handed.
13. \$4,700 entry fee will be used to fund the prize pool. \$300 is a registration fee of which \$50 will go towards staffing.
